## V. FINANCIAL REPORT - Randy Mason

Federal tax return filed last week. A matter relating to a fine is being disputed with the IRS. Undergrads are paid up on rent through November. December is final payment for the Fall, due (\$16,520.00). Need 5 installments during Spring.

Chase account - in good shape from cash flow standpoint barring any unforeseen expenses.

Loan balance is about \$694k, loan matures June 5, 2024. Plan is to refinance. Market is not pricing in any drops in rates until May.

Contracts for next year – have talked to New- I's about living in and the requirement for 2 years. Discussion re: importance of filling Lodge for fundraising and getting loan.

### VI. PROPERTY/RISK MANAGEMENT - Neal Rushforth

Everything going ok.

- 1. Furnishings Harrington statue cabinet all set. Some stuff done in Room 17. Looking ok. We inherited some sofas for in there too.
  - a. Needs: need a budget for the basement so we can renovate at some point.
- 2. Repairs things are ok.
- 3. Maintenance doing some painting. Inspections are done. There was a small hiccup with the kitchen inspection. Hot table was not on, and we are not able to keep leftovers in fridge.
  - a. We need a "food protection manager" on site. We need someone to do this every year.

We could easily spend another \$20k/year on maintenance, but we're scraping by.

Roof and gutters are done, looks great. Next major repair will be Room 28 - Ceiling, etc.

Minor repairs – would be nice for an in-line water pump for the HVAC system. That's about \$3k. Also, would be nice to re-route the cold-water line to the ice machine room.

Undergrads – make sure all windows are closed before you leave for winter break. A couple windows with fans, make sure they're out of there.

Ash - woke up with cold air coming out of the vents. Also, Ash is a certified food "handler".

Todd – more spindles out on banister on  $3^{rd}$  floor. If they come out, please save them and we can put them back in.

Jeremy – would like the new officers to impart a new culture in the Lodge of respect for the property.

- X. NEW BUSINESS
  - a. NEON replacement

We are looking into a possible replacement for the NEON system. NEON costs about \$162/month, which eats up almost all of the dues that we collect through it every year. There are cheaper options that perform the functions that we need, one of which costs \$650/year.

Issue to be revisited after June, 2024.

#### b. Proposed increase in rent

Motion to increase rent from \$4,200 to \$4,400 per semester, with incentive to rebate \$200 to every tenant if all available bedrooms are filled (25 bedrooms). – Hess, second. Motion passes unanimously.

Right now, forecasting 24 guys living in, plus potentials from Spring.
